



### **RESOLUTION & PLACED IMAGES**

All raster artwork should have a **minimum resolution of 200dpi** at 100% scale. Vector artwork should not be rasterized prior to pdf file creation.

### SUBMITTAL

Email your artwork to Lisa Sanchez if it is under 15mb. <u>lisa.sanchez@vermont.gov</u>, OR provide link to file(s) if over 15mb.

### **Recommendations for Advertisers**

- 1. Include directional information with exit number and street address.
- 2. Use attractive, eye-catching photography and images.
- 3. Keep your text brief.
- 4. Use QR codes.

\* SAFE ZONES: IMPORTANT!

Please do not have text or logos

closer than 1/2" from edges of art.

 $\frac{1}{4}$  -  $\frac{3}{8}$  gets covered by framing.

5. Avoid contact info and info that may become outdated.
